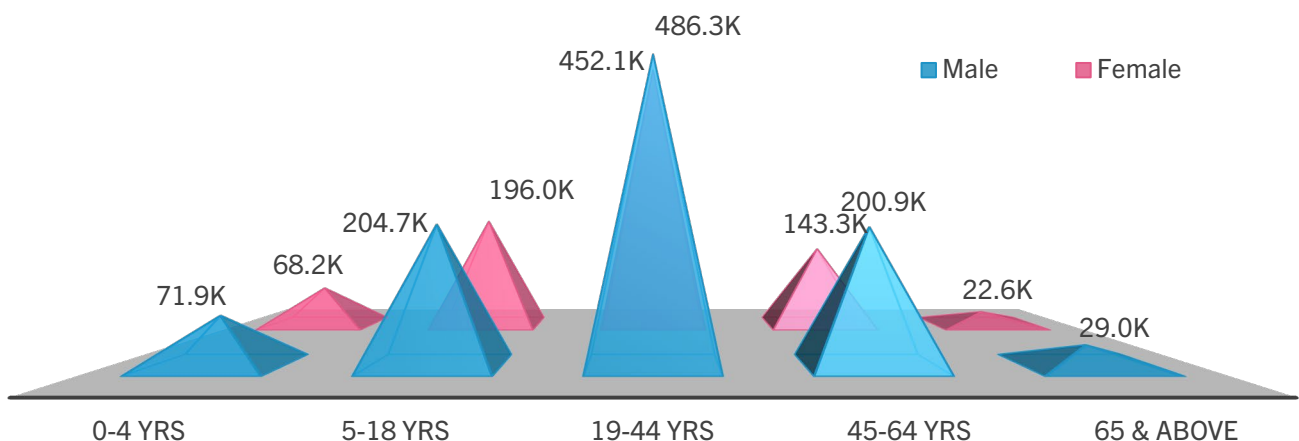

BY GENDER



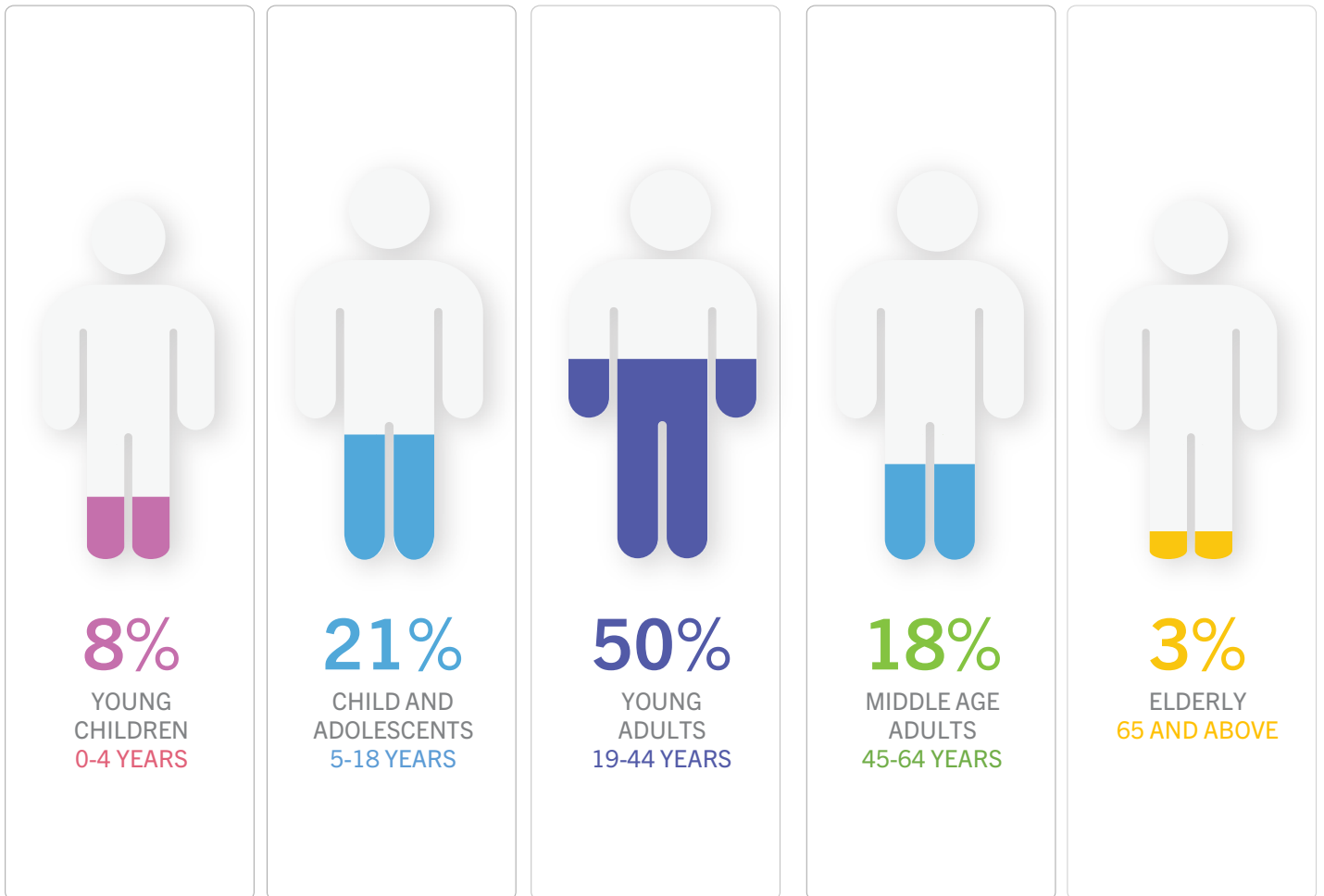
GENDER DISTRIBUTION BY AGE GROUPS



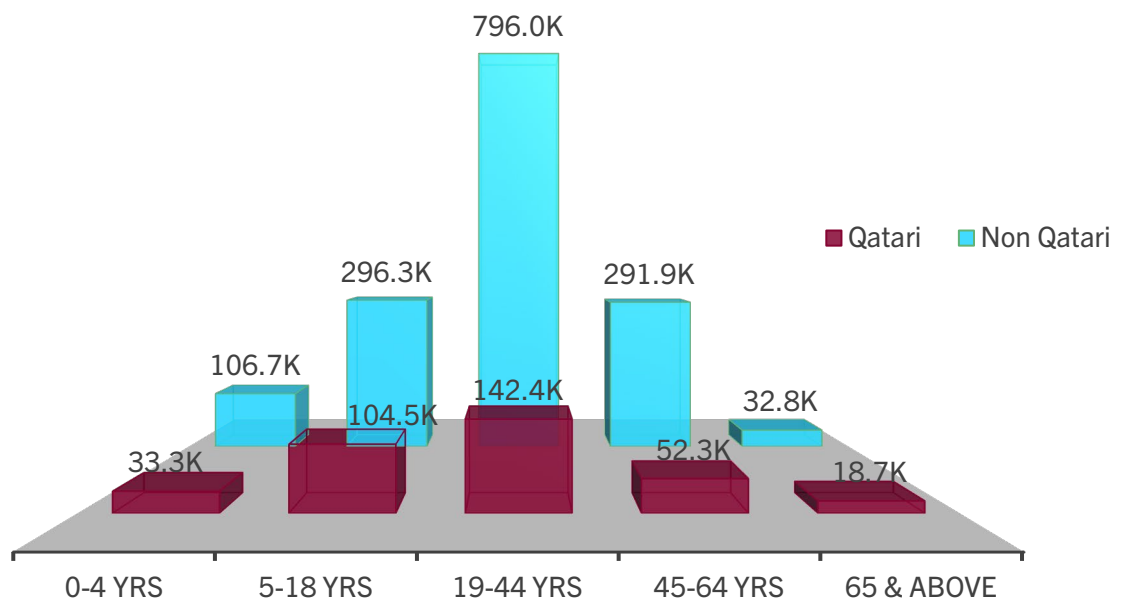

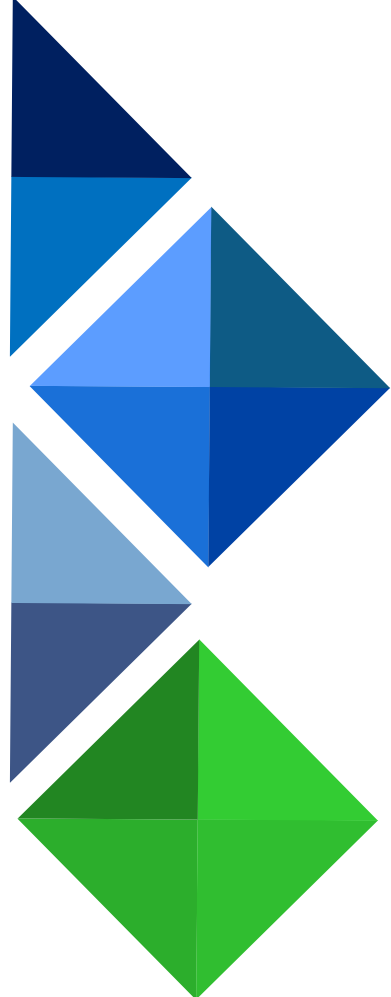

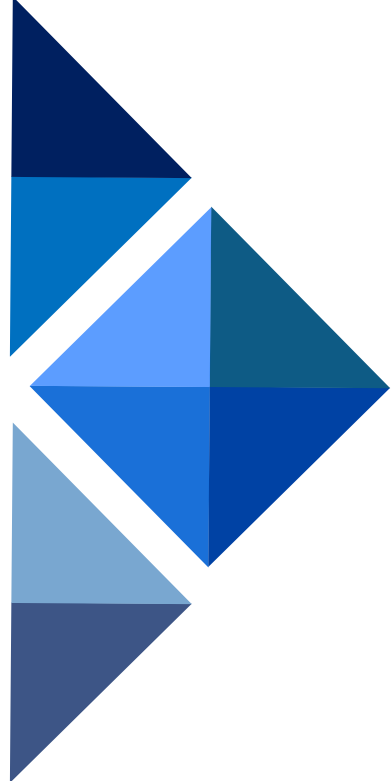
